JUSTICE MAHESH CHANDRA SHARMA

Acting Chairperson, Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission, Jaipur

Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Sharma, former Judge of Rajasthan High Court, (who took the oath of the Judge of the Rajasthan High Court on 5th July, 2007 and remained Judge till his retirement i.e. on 31st May, 2017). He has joined as the Member of the Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission, Jaipur on 3rd October, 2018. Thereafter he has joined as Acting Chairperson of the Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission on 5th December, 2019. He is the Acting Chairperson of the Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission.

Born on 1st June, 1955 in Dausa (Rajasthan)

Justice Sharma completed his Graduation in Science Biology from Government College, Dausa and did his LL.B. and Diploma in Labour Law from the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. Thereafter he has been enrolled as an Advocate at the Rajasthan Bar Council in year 1979. His Enrolement No. is R/161/79. He has started practice in Civil, Criminal, Revenue and constitutional matter in Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur Bench, Jaipur.

He appeared as an Advocate for the Pink City Press Club, Hindustan Times, Rajasthan Patrika, Rajasthan State Mineral Development Corportion, Maharaja Sawai Man Singh (II) Museum Trust City Palace, Jaipur, Jaigarh Public Charitable Trust, Jaigarh Fort, Shri Shila Mataji Trust, Amber Fort, Amber and the Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation.

He has also appeared before the Delhi High Court as well as before the Supreme Court of India in a case of

H.H. late Shri Bhawani Singh Ji (Ex Ruler of Erstwhile State of Jaipur), (A partition suit valued about more than 32 thousand crores (Valuation in 1988))

He has appeared as Additional Advocate General for the State of Rajasthan from year 2000 to 2003 in Rajasthan High Court.

He has also remained Senior Panel Counsel for the Union of India from 2004 to 31st May, 2007.

Thereafter he was elevated as Judge of the Rajasthan High Court on 5th July, 2007 and remained Judge till his retirement i.e. 31st May, 2017.

He remained as Chairman of the Juvenile Justice Board and also remained Member of the various Committees of the Rajasthan High Court.

The most important case, which has been decided by Justice Sharma is **Hingoniya Goshala case**.

Justice Sharma has decided approximately 110902 (One Lakh Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Two cases) in Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur and Principal Seat at Jodhpur.

After retirement he has conducted so many arbitration cases as ordered by the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court.

On 3rd October, 2018, he has joined as Member of the Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission, Jaipur.

On 5th December, 2019, Justice Sharma has been appointed as Acting Chairperson of the Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission, Jaipur.
